



## **Thông Báo – Notice**

**(for church members only)**

The State government recently announced further easing of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions for religious activities starting from 11.59pm December 6, 2020. The changes are outlined below:

- No limits on the number of attendees;
- Indoor and outdoor ceremonies can occur at the same time;
- For venues use electronic record keeping, a density quotient of 1 person per 2 square metre is required to ensure attendees can keep 1.5 metres distance;
- In venues not using electronic record keeping, a density quotient of 1 person per 4 square metre is still applied to ensure attendees can keep 1.5 metres distance;
- Face masks remain mandatory when indoors;
- Cleaning and signage requirements continue to apply.

The Church Committee discussed the above changes and their compliance to meet the church's current circumstances and to ensure the safety of the congregation. As a result, until further notice, the church's COVID-Safe Plan is as follows:

1. The church opens its doors for Sunday worship service only. The service will continue to be delivered via the church ZOOM.
2. As the church does NOT have electronic record keeping, a density quotient of 1 person per 4 square metre is applied meaning there will be a capped number of 150 people for indoor and 300 outdoor.
3. For Sunday worship service's attendance record keeping:
  - *a manual register for bookings to be used;*
  - *bookings can be made in block of 4 weeks in advance;*
  - *a "first in best dressed" rule will be applied;*
  - *all bookings and other church access queries to be made to Head of Security, Deacon Nhan Pham on 0424336161 or 10nhanpham@gmail.com*
